



GETTING THERE

Mantra Legends Hotel is located on the corner of Laycock Street and Surfers Paradise Boulevard. Surfers Paradise is only a 50-minute drive from Brisbane, Queensland's Capital City and just 20 minutes from Coolangatta domestic airport.



CAR PARKING

Car parking is available at Mantra Legends Hotel but is subject to availability due to the limited number of spaces. G-LINK

In July 2014, the face of public transport on the Gold Coast changed forever, with the official commissioning of the Gold Coast light rail. Linking Gold Coast University Hospital in Southport to Broadbeach. A G-Link station is located one block south of Mantra Legends Hotel (Surfers Paradise Boulevard).
