 CONSIST OF INDUSTRY PARTICIPANTS AND OF NO FIXED SIZE AND REPRESENT INDUSTRY BROADLY


• MAY INVITE OBSERVERS

THE IRC'S ROLE

- PARTICIPATION IN THE IRC IS VOLUNTARY
- AISC FROM TIME TO TIME MAY REVIEW THE CONSTITUTION OF THE IRC
- IRC'S PROVIDE AN INDUSTRY ENGAGEMENT MECHANISM THAT IS AT THE CENTRE OF TRAINING PACKAGE DEVELOPMENT
- THE IRC PROVIDES A CONDUIT FOR INDUSTRY FEEDBACK TO GOVERNMENT
- IRC'S WORK WITH AND DIRECT SSO'S TO REVIEW, DEVELOP AND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF TRAINING PACKAGE CONTENT.



- GATHER INDUSTRY INTELLIGENCE TO INFORM AND ADVISE ON TRAINING PACKAGE DEVELOPMENT
- OVERSEE THE DEVELOPMENT AND REVIEW THE TRAINING PACKAGE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF ASIC
- OVERSEE THE DEVELOPMENT OF A WORK PLAN BY THE SSO
- PROVIDE BUSINESS CASES, CASES FOR ENDORSEMENT AND OTHER SUBMISSIONS FOR CONSIDERATION BY ASIC
- PROMOTE THE USE OF VET
- MAY CONSULT WITH TECHNICAL ADVISOR COMMITTEES IF THE NEED ARISES





WHY THE CHANGES

MEAT INDUSTRY TRAINING PACKAGE IS UP TO DATE AND REFLECTS INDUSTRY NEEDS

- NOT ALL OTHER INDUSTRY TRAINING PACKAGES WERE UP TO DATE OR BEING USED BY INDUSTRY
- ALLOWS INDUSTRY TO DRIVE CHANGE AND ADDRESS INDUSTRY NEEDS

• GIVES THE GOVERNMENT THE LAST SAY IN TRAINING PACKAGE DEVELOPMENT
