Sheep Health Monitoring Program

MINTRAC coordinates the NSHMP

- Post mortem data from 11 major processors
- Data gathered at the national level
- Collected on 13 major diseases and conditions
- Feedback to producers via State DPIs
- Feedback to processors –daily reports
- Use in research e.g. cadmium in livers and kidneys
- Roll out into the future

Training Strategic Planning in the Feedlot Industry

MLA funded project to work with ALFA to develop a strategic training plan for the coming three years

- Structuring and supporting in-house training

- Role of accredited training for the industry
